Bonfils-Stanton Foundation Announces Third Quarter Grants

Denver, January 20, 2015 – The Bonfils-Stanton Foundation announced 12 grants totaling \$607,500. The Foundation's grantmaking focuses on the arts and their power to animate places, inspire people, and nurture the creativity that fuels intellectual economy.

Grant award recipients include:
