Bonfils-Stanton Foundation Awards \$553,000 in Arts Grants

More than half a million dollars dispersed among 12 Denver Arts and Cultural organizations

Denver, CO (January 30, 2019) - Bonfils-Stanton Foundation recently announced more than half a million dollars in grants for the Denver arts community. The Foundation awarded \$553,000 to support the artistic endeavors of a dozen local nonprofit organizations.

The grants include support for programs that bring a vibrancy to our city, including longtime Denver organizations such as the Colorado Symphony Association, Denver Architectural Foundation and Swallow Hill Music as well as backing newer projects such as Rainbow Militia and Denver Digerati.

"We are pleased to strengthen established programs and to help provide for new innovative works that increase cultural participation, connect art and community, and enhance the profile of Denver's art scene," Gina Ferrari, Director of the Foundations Grants Program, said. "We are also pleased to offer multi-year support to Cleo Parker Robinson Dance, Su Teatro and Stories on Stage in recognition of the progress and stability of these community-focused organizations, and as part of our commitment to building equity in our grantmaking," noted Ms. Ferrari. Since its founding, Bonfils-Stanton Foundation has distributed over \$70 million in charitable contributions.
