Bonfils-Stanton Foundation Awards \$1.9 Million in Denver Arts & Culture Grants

Denver, CO (August 12, 2021) – Bonfils-Stanton Foundation recently approved \$1.9 million in arts & culture grants. The foundation recognizes the ongoing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic and hopes this quarter's awarded grants will help with continued recovery for the arts & culture sector.

"Bonfils-Stanton Foundation is pleased with the significant awards approved at the July Board Meeting. These 21 organizations continue to bring creativity and passion to Denver and its communities during a time when art & culture is so desperately needed to uplift our spirits, our voices and bring us safely together," says Director of Grants Programs Gina Ferrari. "The diversity of these organizations truly reflects our communities and contribute to Denver's vibrancy. We look forward to seeing our newer grantees' programs come to life along with exciting activities and seasons for our returning grantees."

RedLine, as administrator, was the largest recipient with a three-year grant to support the Arts in Society grantmaking initiative, totaling \$600,000 (\$200,000 annually). Other grantees included Phamaly Theatre Company, D3 Arts, Colorado Black Arts Movement and Mexican Cultural Center. - **D3 Arts** (\$20,000) for general operating in support of artistic programs of D3 Arts (BuCu West fiscal sponsor)
